L2- James B for working hard and having great achievements.

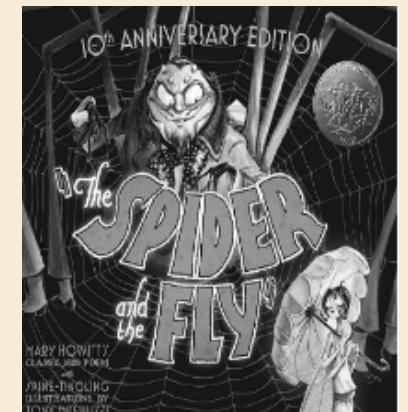
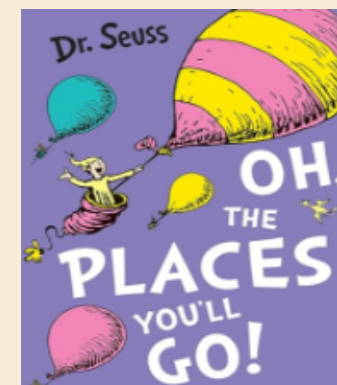
