

## Greenacre School - Remote Learning Offer

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Greenacre has adapted to the increasing need for remote learning and strives to provide a bespoke learning offer which mirrors the curriculum accessed within school whilst meeting the individual needs of our learners.

### Remote learning offer

The remote learning offer will be differentiated according to pupil need and may include:

- Live taught sessions (through Google Meet)
- Work tasks set and shared through Seesaw
- Website links to school programmes
- Printed resource packs

If you are having difficulty accessing online resources please contact school so we are able to support you with this.

### How much work will be set?

In the event of a whole or partial closure, our remote learning offer reflects the in-school timetable and the quantity of work set is in line with government guidelines. This differs between departments as detailed below:

Department	What to expect?
Freeflow (inc Oak 1 and Kex 1)	-Live learning Literacy and Numeracy sessions daily -Daily tasks set through Seesaw -Daily/Weekly contact from class team (Minimum of 3 hours learning per day)
Cool (including Oak 2 and Kex 2)	-Live learning Literacy and Numeracy sessions daily -Daily tasks set through Seesaw to mirror in school timetable -Daily/Weekly contact from class team (Minimum of 4 hours learning per day)
Lifeskills (including Carlton)	-Live learning Literacy and Numeracy sessions daily -Daily tasks set through Seesaw to mirror in school timetable -Daily/Weekly contact from class team (Minimum of 4 hours learning per day)
College	-Live learning Literacy and Numeracy sessions daily -Daily tasks set through Seesaw to mirror in school timetable -Daily/Weekly contact from class team (Minimum of 4 hours learning per day)

### How will work be shared?

Links to all online learning will be shared through [Seesaw](#). These will include links to other programmes used within school including Google Meet, Purple Mash and Education City. If you require any support accessing these programmes please contact your child's class team or call school and we will ensure someone calls you back.

### What support is available?

We recognise that some pupils may not be able to access some parts of our remote learning offer. While all work is differentiated, we acknowledge the difficulties this may place on families. The school is here to support and will be in regular contact to check how things are going at home. If you have any requests/questions about home learning please share these with class staff so we can ensure the offer is meeting your needs as much as possible. You can contact us through Seesaw or by phone at any time to seek pastoral or learning support.
